THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION.

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 514/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 April 2014 laying down general provisions on the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and on the instrument for financial support for police cooperation, preventing and combating crime, and crisis management¹, and in particular Article 14(7) thereof.

Whereas:

- (1) On 7 October 2014, Cyprus submitted, through the Commission's electronic data exchange system (SFC2014), a proposed national programme for support from the Internal Security Fund for the period from 2014 to 2020.
- (2) The policy dialogue with Cyprus referred to in Article 13 of Regulation (EU) No 514/2014 took place on 4 October 2013. The outcome is recorded in agreed minutes dated 18 February 2014.
- (3) The proposed national programme was drawn up by Cyprus with the involvement of the partnership referred to in Article 12 of Regulation (EU) No 514/2014.
- (4) The national programme contains all the elements referred to in Article 14(2) of Regulation (EU) No 514/2014.
- (5) Pursuant to Article 14(6) of Regulation (EU) No 514/2014, the Commission made observations on 5 December 2014, 20 March 2015 and 14 July 2015. Cyprus provided the Commission with all necessary additional information on 12 February 2015 and on 29 May 2015 and amended the national programme accordingly. The amended programme was submitted to the Commission on 15 July 2015.
- (6) This Decision constitutes a financing decision within the meaning of Article 84 of Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council² and a legal commitment within the meaning of Article 85 of that Regulation.
- (7) The amount of the maximum contribution to the national programme of Cyprus from the Internal Security Fund should be indicated,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The national programme of Cyprus for support from the Internal Security Fund for the period from 1 January 2014 to 31 December 2020, as submitted in its final version on 15 July 2015, is hereby approved.

Article 2

The maximum contribution from the Internal Security Fund to the national programme of Cyprus is set at EUR 42 624 287, to be financed from the general budget of the Union as follows:

- (a) budget line 18 02 01 01: EUR 34 507 030
- (b) budget line 18 02 01 02: EUR 8 117 257

Article 3

This Decision is addressed to the Republic of Cyprus.
